Education in an International Context

The University of Bath, UK, in conjunction with École Mondiale World School, Mumbai, India, offers an opportunity for qualified educators to participate in the University's MA in Education programmes. The full MA programme comprises five taught units and a dissertation. Each taught unit is followed by individual research and the submission of a 5,000 word written assignment.

In April 2020 the Education in an International Context unit will be taught in Mumbai. The unit, which is relevant to teachers of all age ranges, explores the concept of international education through a consideration of value systems and ideologies, international schools, international curricula, issues relating to students and teachers, and models for international education. It will draw on the experience of participants from both national and international contexts.

Participants may use the Masters level credits gained by successful completion of this unit towards the International Baccalaureate Educator Certificates (previously known as IB Teacher Awards Levels 1 and 2).
